



## **Release: Situation of Peru**

Peru is executing several actions in order to assist and provide orientation to national and international tourists in the different regions of the country.

In this context, be informed that, as of today December 27, all the regional airports have restarted their operations, with the exception of Apurimac, a service that is not commercial. Meanwhile, the airports of Arequipa, Ayacucho, Cusco and Puno have resumed their flight operations for all passengers.

Also, the railway operations on the Route Cusco – Ollantaytambo – Machupicchu – Hydroelectric of the southeast rail, and the railway operations on the Cusco – Puno and Juliaca – Arequipa routes of the southern rail have resumed as well.

In addition, since 21th December tickets to Machupicchu are being sold again, which also includes the Network of Inca Roads. The tickets can be acquired virtually in the web of the Culture Ministry of Peru (<a href="https://www.machupicchu.gob.pe/">https://www.machupicchu.gob.pe/</a>) and also in person at the *Direction Desconcentrada de Cultura de Cusco* (Street Maruri 324, Cusco 08002).

The archaeological centers of Saqsaywaman, Q'enqo, Puka Pukara, Tambomachay, Pisaq, Chinchero, Ollantaytambo, Moray, Tipon and Pikillaqta are also open to the public.
